

## **Outhouse & Greywater Pit Information – Twin Lakes Beach**

Outhouses and greywater pits do not require application and registration with Manitoba Conservation.

A dwelling can only have a greywater pit if they are not serviced by a water system under pressure. A greywater pit has to be:

- >15m (50ft) from a drilled well
- >30m (100ft) from a natural spring
- >30m (100ft) from the high-water mark of a water body
- >3m (10ft) from the property boundary
- >1m (3.25ft) of soil depth from bottom of pit to the water table

A dwelling can have a outhouse if:

- >6m (20ft) from a dwelling
- >15m (50ft) from a water well
- Built with quality materials
- Weatherproof
- Vented
- Sanitary
- Fly proof
- Maintained over time
